USS *Kidd* (DDG-100) is an *Arleigh Burke*-class destroyer in the United States Navy. She is the third Navy ship named after Rear Admiral Isaac C. Kidd, who was on board *Arizona* during the attack on Pearl Harbor, and was the first American flag officer to die in World War II.

*Kidd* was christened on 22 January 2005 at Ingalls Shipbuilding in Pascagoula, Mississippi. The ship was damaged at the shipyard docks during Hurricane Katrina on the Mississippi Gulf Coast, requiring a return to the dry dock for repairs, delaying her commissioning and deployment with the Navy. She was commissioned in Galveston, Texas on June 9, 2007. She is currently home ported in San Diego, CA

One of the recent awards we presented was at the Army and Navy Academy. The JROTC program at Army and Navy Academy in Carlsbad, CA consists of four levels of Leadership Education Training (LET) instruction. Army and Navy Academy awards credit toward graduation for each year of the JROTC program.

The curriculum is linked to the McREL (instructional leadership resource) national standards. Every lesson and assessment actively engages students in higher-order thinking, along with skill performance. The program of instruction provides the flexibility to link the standards for elective credit and additional credit in subject areas such as physical education, health, wellness, life management skills, freshman orientation, government, civics, practical and performing arts, careers and so forth.

The main goal of all JROTC learning experiences is the cadet's success. The JROTC curriculum is based on the principles of performance-based, learner-centered education.
