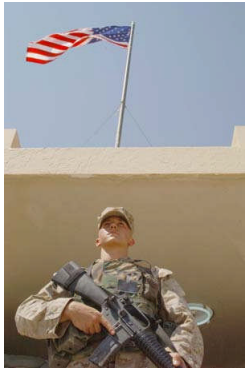
This event is a "Must Do" event: This is the **FIRST** Commissioning of a "Capital Ship" in many years, and it won't happen again soon in San Diego
