We had a great turnout and tour on Wednesday, February 22, 2006 of the U.S. COAST GUARD BASE IN SAN DIEGO AND THE NORTH ISLAND CORONADO ASSAULT CRAFT UNIT ONE NAVY AMPHIBIOUS BASE.

The U.S. Coast Guard Base in San Diego conducts maritime law enforcement. Also, ensuring Homeland Security, the Station escorts each cruise ship and some Navy assets as they enter and leave San Diego Bay.

At the Navy Amphibious Base we boarded a Landing Craft Unit and took a tour the harbor for a very different view of the Navy ships! Assault Craft Unit (ACU) ONE has approximately 350 personnel assigned and is responsible for 16 Landing Craft Utility (LCU). ACU ONE was established 1947.

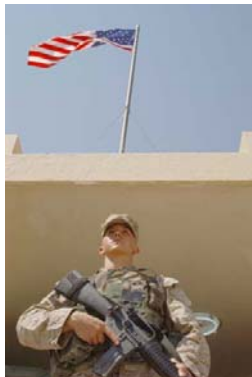
