Recognizing the value of these organizations in educating youth in maritime matters, the Department of the Navy established the Naval Sea Cadet Corps (NSCC) and Navy League Cadet Corps (NLCC) in 1958.

The basic objectives of both programs are: (1) to help young Americans become more patriotic and responsible citizens and (2) to help them understand the role of the maritime services in national defense and maintaining the economic viability of our nation.

Great News! Tri-City Council is in the process of adopting the USCGC Haddock which is stationed in San Diego. A Navy League Council adopts a ship for the purpose of concentrating its efforts in public and community relations on that ship or unit, its officers and crew. The Haddock is the forty-seventh vessel of the Marine Protector Class of the Coast Guard Patrol Boats. She is 87 feet in length and carries a crew of 1 officer and 10 enlisted personnel. Her primary missions include Search and Rescue, Homeland Security and Law Enforcement. More information will follow in upcoming issues of The Log!

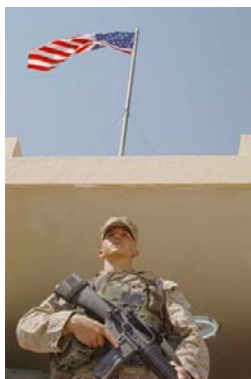
