Re: **REPORT FOR JULY AND AUGUST 2006**

1. Current unit strength is 26 NSCC Cadets, 14 League Cadets, 10 Officers, Midshipmen, and Instructors. We will continue to encourage recruiting. Our next "Prospective Cadet" meeting is scheduled for 0900 hours on Saturday, 23 SEP 2006.
2. No drills are held during the months of July and August in order to enable the Cadets to prepare and attend summer trainings. To date the following trainings have successfully been completed:
 - **US Naval Sea Cadet Corps - Twelve (12) Cadets** attended Recruit Training and Advanced Trainings in the month of July. 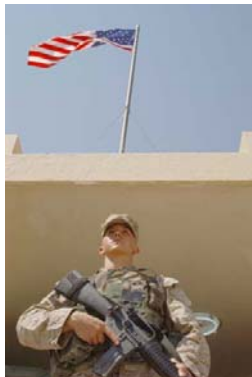
